To Play

1. Click the Open button.
2. From the Open dialog box navigate through Search Folders, Date Folders and Label Folders until you reveal the required recording.
3. Double click the required recording, or select it and click Open.
4. Click Play or depress the play switch on the foot control to play.
5. Click Play or release the play switch on the foot control to stop play.
6. Click Scan Forward or depress the foot control fast forward switch to move rapidly forward.
7. Click Scan Back or depress the foot control rewind switch to move rapidly back.
8. Drag the Master Volume Control up or down to adjust the overall volume, or drag the Channel Volume Controls up or down to adjust individual channels.
